



New Sugar House Temporary Shelter January 23 - April 15, 2020 10 p.m. - 7 a.m.



Overnight hours (the “warming center”) at the Weigand Homeless Resource Center will end Jan. 23, and the new Sugar House Temporary Shelter will open that night. The Temporary Shelter is a winter overflow shelter like St. Vincent de Paul Dining Hall and will offer cots, mats and blankets for sleeping.

- Please **check in** at the Wiegand Center between **7 p.m. and 11 p.m.** to access the new Sugar House Temporary Shelter. After 11 p.m., check in at St. Vincent de Paul Dining Hall.
- **Transportation** will be provided each night and morning between Wiegand Center and the Sugar House Temporary Shelter, with expanded service to the Homeless Resource Centers.
- Weigand Center will remain open until **11 p.m.**
- **Men and women** will be served in separated areas of the new temporary shelter.
- **Storage** of limited personal belongings (what a person can carry on their own) will be available at the Sugar House Temporary Shelter.

EXPECTATIONS

- The Sugar House Temporary Shelter is for individuals who want to sleep.
- Possession or use of alcohol, drugs, or weapons in the facility is not allowed.
- Keep your hands and feet to yourself.
- Guests are responsible for their own property.
- Sexual harassment, lewd conduct or public displays of affection with ANYONE is no allowed.
