
## It all started with the Peregrine...

The Peregrine Fund was founded in 1970 to restore the Peregrine Falcon, which was removed from the U.S. Endangered Species List in 1999. That success encouraged the organization to expand its focus and apply its experience and understanding to raptor conservation efforts. We work on behalf of all 559 raptor species across 6 continents, including the California Condor and Aplomado Falcon in the United States. The organization is non-political, solution-oriented and hands-on.


# THE FOUNDERS


Kaddas Enterprises all started in the family kitchen oven in 1966.
