Double Fatal Traffic Accident

NORTH OGDEN CASE 22NO5831
May 21st, 2022

At about 2:30 am on Saturday, May 21st, 2022, in the 700 block of 3100 N in North Ogden, a North Ogden City Police Officer attempted to make a traffic stop on a vehicle for minor traffic violations. The vehicle immediately took off west bound on 3100 N at a high rate of speed. Within seconds, as the vehicle went through the intersection of 450 E 3100 N the officer said he saw sparks and then the vehicle left the roadway and hit a tree. There were five male occupants in the vehicle ranging in age from late teens to early twenties. As a result of the accident, two of the passengers died at the scene. The other three were transported to area hospitals. Their exact conditions are currently unknown. Investigators are working on identifying those involved and making proper notifications. At this time, it is unclear why the driver of the vehicle took off when the officer attempted the traffic stop. Investigators are still trying to determine if impairment was a factor, however, alcohol and marijuana were located inside of the vehicle. The Weber County Crash Team, Weber Metro CSI, and the medical examiner are assisting with the investigation.
