
The new legislation says we need to tell everyone that if you were assigned a girl at birth, you need to use the girl's bathroom at school.

The new legislation says we need to tell everyone that if you were assigned a boy at birth, you need to use the boy's bathroom at school.

If you have a question about which bathroom you should use, talk your parent, teacher, counselor, or the principal.





This law goes into effect on May 1, 2024.

- If you experience any bullying or have concerns about what is happening in a restroom tell your principal.
- You can report bullying or safety concerns using the SafeUT app.

It is not good for your body if you try to hold it and do not go to the bathroom when you need to.






We will help you.
